

### English

Our class storybook is 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. The children will be learning to write recipes, instructions and slogans. They will also experience 'nonsense' poetry and learn how to write a 'Rags to Riches' story.

We will be having daily Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling lessons and regular guided reading lessons.



### Geography

We research the journey taken by a banana from its country of origin to the fruit bowl. The children will use a range of sources to gather information and plot routes on a world map.



### Maths

To start this half term, the children will be learning to solve everyday and other Maths problems, by using and improving their multiplication and division skills. Later in the term we will be learning about different measures skills. We will also have daily practice of basic skills.



### Art / Design Technology

The children will observe and draw different fruits and vegetables, looking carefully at detail, such as colour, pattern and form. They will take part in cooking activities that need mathematical skills to re-weigh and measure accurately. Follow simple instructions or recipes, planning the ingredients and tools needed.

### Science (Nutrition)
