Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 3 Greek Day

During the second part of the Autumn Term Year 3 will be learning about the Ancient Greeks and their impact on modern life. To tie with this topic, on Friday 8th November there will be a Greek Workshop at school all day for the Year 3 pupils. It would be great if your child could dress up for this. This could be a robe (an old sheet) or an adult size plain white t-shirt, with a belt or cord to tie around their waist. However if they do not wish to dress up they will need to wear school uniform as usual.

The Greek Workshop, delivered by Sir Teachalot (an Ancient Greek visitor) will include learning about the lives of the rich and poor, the lives of men and women, the lives of children, slavery, The Greeks at war, Sparta and Athens, Democracy, Greek Myths and the Olympics. It promises to be a fun and exciting day with lots of hands on learning.

You are invited to contribute £6.75 per pupil, £5.00 for those who have provided proof that they are in receipt of Income Support, Income based Jobseekers Allowance, Income related Employment & Support, or some Child Tax Credits (not Working Tax Credits). The contribution is voluntary. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear any of the cost of the workshop without reducing its ability to provide all the books and materials that are essential for its curricular needs, the workshop will not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute. If you are unable to contribute you are invited to contact Mrs Kidd in confidence so that suitable arrangements can be made to cover the cost of your child's participation.
