

Science

In science this term we will be learning all about nocturnal animals and their prey.



We will differentiate between living, dead and non-living things, learning what makes something living. Also we will be learning about the basic needs of animals and their offspring. We will be investigating different habitats and exploring simple food chains.



In addition to this we will be looking at where our food comes from and how our food goes from farm to fork.

Maths

This term we will be revising written methods and using jottings and drawings to calculate all four operations: add, subtract, multiply and divide. We will also be completing balanced equations and finding missing numbers in equations.

We will be estimating answers and using estimates to check an answer is appropriate. We will also be using inverse to check answers are correct.

We will also be investigating volume and capacity looking at different measures and different units of measure.



Art



As part of our nocturnal animal topic we will be using drawing, painting and sculpture to make different animals and habitats.

Music

This term we will continue to learn the recorder and learn new songs about nocturnal animals and minibeasts.

We will also listen to, discuss and give opinions on a variety of recorded music.



PE


This term we will be playing lots of team games, learning to follow rules and work together.



English

This term we will be reading 'The owl who was afraid of the dark'. From this we will write descriptions of the main character and write poetry based on owls.

We will also be learning about other nocturnal creatures and use this knowledge to make non-fiction booklets.



SPAG

In spelling  we be focussing on spelling of key words and rules for different endings (suffixes).

In grammar we will be revising the meanings of noun, verb, adverb, adjectives and conjunctions. We will be finding and editing these to make our writing more interesting.

Modern Foreign Languages

In Year 2 this term we will be continuing to learn simple Italian, including numbers, colours, clothing and key phrases.
